

HELPS US TO ENSURE SUITABLE STEPS FOR THE BENEFIT AND PROGRESS OF OUR STUDENTS. DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH LANGUAGE CATERS ALL THE STUDENTS IN FOUNDATION COURSE AND IN LITERATURE.

IN FOUNDATION COURSE ENGLISH LANGUAGE IN THE VERY FIRST YEAR OF THEIR COURSE STUDENTS OF ALL FACULTIES FACE PROBLEMS. SO THE EXTRA CARE AND EXTRA EFFORT IS NEEDED FOR THEM. IN THE SECOND YEAR AND THE FINAL YEAR OF THE COURSE THEY EXCEL IN THEIR PERFORMANCE WHICH OBVIOUS IN THEIR RESULTS. WE CREATE FOLLOWING TIPS FOR OUR STUDENTS....MAKING PROCESS MORE STUDENT CENTRIC:

STUDENTS WHO NEED MORE ATTENTION ARE TAKEN CARE OF. SLOW LEARNERS ARE IDENTIFIED ON THE BASIS OF THEIR ATTENDANCE IN THEIR CLASS, THEIR CONCENTRATION AND ATTENTION TOWARDS THE SUBJECT, THEIR PERFORMANCE IN THE UNIT TESTS AND ORAL QUESTION AND ANSWERS.

IN THE FIRST YEAR ALMOST EACH AND EVERY STUDENT NEED SPECIAL ATTENTION. AND IT IS VERY DIFFICULT TO DIFFERENTIATE AS IN SLOW LEARNER AND FAST LEARNERS. SO WE TAKE CARE OF ENTIRE CLASS WITH SPECIAL ATTENTION AND DO THE FOLLOWING NEEDFUL.

- 1. PROVIDING BRIEFS
- 2. CREATION 10 POINT SUMMARY OF EACH CHAPTER OF THE BOOK IN TEXT.
- SOLVING EXERCISES OF TEXT BOOK.
- 4. EXTRA EMPHASIS ON GRAMMAR CLASSES.
- 5. BRIEFS ARE PREPARED KEEPING IN MIND IMPORTANT QUESTIONS AND GRAMMATICAL SENTENCES FOR THEIR ANNUAL EXAMS

6. WE EVEN STICK THESE BRIEFS ON THE WALLS OF FIRST YEAR CLASS ROOMS FOR TIME BEING SO THAT EVERY STUDENT CAN GET ACCESS TO THESE.

- 7. THEN WE CONDUCT INTERNAL EVALUATION TESTS IN THE SESSION TO IDENTIFY SLOW LEARNERS AND FAST LEARNERS.
- 8. EVEN IN THE UNIT TESTS WE PREPARE THEM WITH QUESTIONS ANSWERS SO THAT THEY CAN SCORE GOOD MARKS AND THEN WHICH IS ADDED IN THEIR FINAL RESULTS.

THING ARE MORE DIFFICULT IN THE POST GRADUATE COURSES... DEPARTMENT HAS VERY LOW NUMBER OF STUDENT IN LITERATURE UNDER GRADUATE COURSE AND POST GRADUATE LEVEL GETS ITS STUDENTS FROM THE SCIENCE AND ART FACULTY (OTHER THAN LITERATURE) STREAM. AND ARE UNAWARE OF THE SYLLABUS.

EVERY YEAR IN EVERY CLASS THERE ARE STUDENT WHO MAKING THEIR TEACHERS PROUD NOT ONLY IN TERMS OF MARKS BUT ALSO WITH THEIR UNDERSTANDING OF SUBJECT AND ATTENDANCE AND CONCENTRATION IN THE CLASS. WE TRY TO PREPARE THEM FOR FURTHER ADVANCE COURSES AND COMPETITIVE EXAMS.

AS ENGLISH LANGUAGE IS IMPORTANT FOR ALL OVER DEVELOPMENT AND IN ALL COMPETITIVE LEVELS WE FIND IT THERE AND THE MOST DIFFICULT PART OF THEIR PROGRAMME.

WE PROVIDE THEM WITH IMPORTANT READING MATERIAL, BESIDE THEIR SUBJECT MATERIAL, AND ENCOURAGE THEM MORE TOWARDS SPOKEN ENGLISH AND USAGE ENGLISH.

FAST LEARNER

POST GRADUATE COURSE HAS 30 SEATS AND WE GET ALMOST ON AN AVERAGE 60-70 APPLICATIONS FOR ADMISSION. AND WE GET ON AN AVERAGE 15-20 STUDENTS TO THE COURSE.

DIFFICULT TO BIFURCATE FAST LEARNERS AND SLOW LEARNERS BECAUSE ALL ARE NEW TO THE COURSE. INITIALLY AND IN THE FIRST SEMESTER REALLY DIFFICULT TO DIFFERENTIATE...SLOWLY THEY START TAKING UP THE SUBJECT AND WE CAN SEE THE DIFFERENCE.

TO THE FAST LEARNERS WE MAKE THEN UNDERSTAND THE IMPORTANCE OF EACH PAPER SO THAT THEY CAN TAKE UP ANY ONE OF THEM FOR THEIR FURTHER STUDIES AFTER THEIR POST GRADUATE LEVEL.

WE TRY TO ORIENT THEM TOWARD RESEARCH PROCESS, WRITING PROJECTS, TRY TO HELP THEM IN COMPETITIVE EXAMS....NET/SET AND MANY OTHERS.
